Guide on Basic Touch Gestures and Navigation in Android TalkBack

Topic: Android Accessibility (TalkBack Touch Gestures)

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Having TalkBack running changes how you interact with your touchscreen. So now that I've got TalkBack on, I can just simply move one finger around the screen to hear what's under my finger, and nothing will actually be activated yet.

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "Gemini."

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "Moovit."

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "Trainpal. WhatsApp has 1 notification."

That's just me moving my finger along to find what's on that row. Now, there are easier ways of finding what's on your screen. So if you don't know where the thing you're looking for is on your screen, you can simply touch on the top left of your screen...

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "Spotify."

And then if I do a quick flick gesture from left to right, it's going to move my focus to the next item and tell me what the next item is.

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "PayPal, Pass, Excel."

Same if I then do a swipe back the other way from right to left, it'll take me to the previous item.

[Screen Feedback / TalkBack Voice]: "Spotify."

Now, if I want to activate that item, I simply do a double tap, again with one finger, and that will activate.
